**2. Pachgani:**

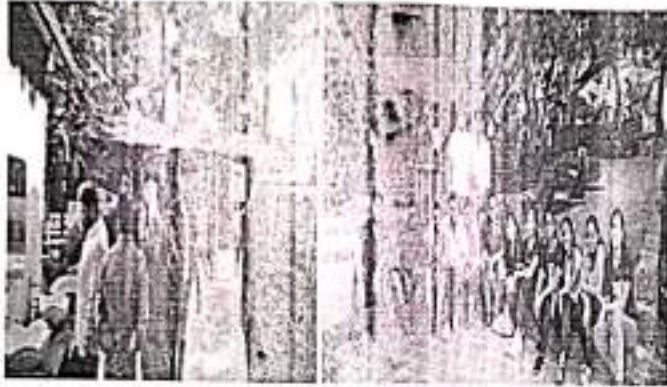
