THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING MADE AT SASWAD ON THE 1ST
JANUARY- 2023

BETWEEN

Department of Microbiology, Waghire College, Saswad and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Waghire College, Saswad, both located at Pune District Education Association's (PDEA), Waghire College Saswad, Tal: Purandar, Dist: Pune - 412301. The College was established in 1972 and spread over of 11 acres. College has actively involved in various research activities and also received DST-FIST grant from Department of Science and Technology.

SANA RICA FOODS registered under the having its registered office AT: 669/3, Swapnapoorti, Ground floor, Opposite Om Alankar Society, Roopali Hotel Lane, Bibwewadi, Pune-411037, having Registration no. 1831000312717292 (hereinafter referred to as the "SRF" which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) represented through its Authorised Signatory.

Whereas, the SRF is involved in activities relating to the manufacturing and exports of food coating systems and food ingredients at its Jejuri MIDC facility since last 10 years,

And whereas, SRF proposes to get their food ingredients each commercial batch samples tested for physical, chemical and microbiological paramaters on weekly basis and process water samples to be checked by a reputed laboratory once in 6 months ,

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS UNDER:-

1. OBJECTIVES UNDER THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- i. It is hereby agreed by and between the parties that SRF will provide free product samples and water samples to the students and staff of Waghire College for testing purpose.
- ii. It is hereby agreed that the College will support for the activities of SRF like helping to conduct seminars/ workshop, Survey in which students/ staff will help to provide basic information about the testing parameters , methodology etc.
- iii. This will also help to generate curiosity and to inculcate food testing research activities among the students.
- iv. It is hereby agreed between the parties that all parties will work mutually in order to get weekly product testing results to SRF.

2. COVENANTS BY THE SRF

- i. SRF will provide working place, infrastructure facility and field area for research work if required.
- ii. SRF assures the College that SRF is legally and validly organised and is in existence as on the date of this MOU and has an established track record of 10 years in undertaking similar programmes or projects.
- iii. SRF shall ensure that the beneficiaries to derive the full benefit under this MOU.
- iv. SRF shall maintain and keep accurately the records of utilization of facilities of SRF by the college from time to time.
- v. SRF ensures that the benefits of this Memorandum of Understanding are for a non-commercial purpose and for the benefit of the community at large.
- vi. SRF will provide the Expertise and basic Resources which are available and required for the different activities under this MoU.
- vii. Common interest is to implement policies aimed for sustainable development and management.
- viii. Exchange of the Experience, knowledge, specialization, mutually beneficial to meet the objectives.
- ix. Planning, development and implementation of the Joint projects and programmes.

3. COVENANTS BY THE COLLEGE

- i. The College will provide knowledge support for food products laboratory testing on and research activities.
- ii. The college will provide major inputs required for the testing of food products.
- iii. College will provide the Expertise and Resources which are available and required for the different activities under this MoU.
- iv. The representative staff nominated by the College shall visit SRF to assess the progress made by Students and SRF in respect of the terms and conditions under this Memorandum of Understanding. SRF shall co-operate with the representatives so as to achieve the objectives of this Memorandum of Understanding.

SRF shall meticulously maintain by means of hard copies, record books or in an electronic format details monitoring the project in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this Memorandum of Understanding.

1. **Collection of food samples of different products manufactured by SRF as and when agreed mutually.**
2. **To understand the processes and methodology required to analyse the samples as per FSSAI and FSSC 22000 standards.**
3. **To carry out the laboratory testing of food products and to maintain batch wise record of the same to be shared with SRF from time to time.**
