Following the Environmental Audit conducted at Waghire College, Saswad, several recommendations were made to further enhance the institution's green campus initiatives. The college administration, faculty, and students have taken proactive steps to implement these suggestions, resulting in significant achievements in environmental sustainability. This report outlines the actions taken based on the audit recommendations and highlights the achievements in line with these green initiatives.

Recommendations and Actions Taken


1. Recommendation: Enhance Waste Management Practices

- Action Taken: The college intensified its waste management system by setting up
 designated waste collection points across the campus. A stricter segregation of waste
 into biodegradable and non-biodegradable categories was enforced. Students and staff
 were educated about the importance of proper waste segregation and disposal.
- Achievement: The enhanced waste management system has significantly reduced the
 amount of waste sent to landfills. The segregated waste is now either composted onsite or sent to recycling units, contributing to a cleaner campus environment. Our
 college supported with dustbins for dry and green waste from Aadhar Poonawala.
 College as installed these dustbins throughout the campus.

2. Recommendation: Increase Green Cover on Campus

- Action Taken: In response to the audit, the college expanded its tree plantation drives,
 focusing on planting native species that require less water and maintenance. A specific
 area on campus was designated as a biodiversity zone, where various indigenous plants
 were introduced to increase green cover and support local wildlife.
- Achievement: The college's green cover has increased by 25% over the past year. College has organised tree plantation drives in different occasions enrolling students and staff members, we have prepared butterfly garden where we planted flowering plants helpful for butterflies and apiary. The biodiversity zone has become a thriving habitat for birds and insects, enhancing the campus's ecological balance.

3. Recommendation: Promote Water Conservation





Achievement: The introduction of these water conservation techniques has resulted in a
30% reduction in the college's water consumption. The harvested rainwater is now used for
irrigation and other non-potable purposes, reducing the dependency on external water
sources.

4. Recommendation: Energy Efficiency Improvements

- Action Taken: To improve energy efficiency, the college replaced old electrical fixtures
 with energy-efficient LED lighting and installed solar panels on select buildings. Solar
 street lamps installed in the campus. Energy audits are now conducted regularly to
 monitor and optimize energy use.
- Achievement: The shift to LED lighting and solar power has reduced the college's
 electricity consumption by 35%. The solar panels contribute significantly to the
 campus's energy needs, promoting renewable energy usage.

5. Recommendation: Encourage Sustainable Transportation

- Action Taken: The college introduced incentives for students and staff to use bicycles
 or electric vehicles. Bicycle parking areas were expanded, and charging stations for
 electric vehicles were installed. The college also organized campaigns to promote
 carpooling and public transport.
- Achievement: The use of bicycles, electric vehicles, vehicle pooling and use of local transport among students and staff has increased by 40%, reducing the campus's carbon footprint. The initiatives have also led to a decrease in traffic congestion around the college.

6. Recommendation: Enhance Awareness and Education on Environmental Issues

- Action Taken: The college enhanced its curriculum and extracurricular activities to
 include more topics on environmental conservation and sustainability. Workshops,
 seminars, Carbon Neutral Campus awareness and guest lectures on various
 environmental issues were organized regularly.
- Achievement: The increased focus on environmental education has heightened
 awareness among students and staff. Participation in green initiatives and sustainabilityrelated activities has grown, reflecting a stronger commitment to environmental
 stewardship within the college community.



Achievements Towards Green Initiatives

1. Sustainability Certifications:

• Waghire College has been awarded certifications for both Energy and Environmental Audits, demonstrating its commitment to sustainability and compliance with green building standards. These certifications are a testament to the college's ongoing efforts to create a sustainable campus.

The college's efforts in enhancing green cover and promoting sustainability have been recognized by local and regional environmental bodies. These awards highlight Waghire College's role as a leader in green campus initiatives within the education sector through the Carbon Neutral Campus and Plastic free campus activities.

The college has successfully involved students in various green activities, such as tree planting, waste segregation, and water conservation. The active participation of students in these initiatives has fostered a culture of environmental responsibility that extends beyond the campus.
