





Report on Workshop 'How to Prepare Research Proposal'

Date:-24/08/2022

The Department of English organised online one day workshop 'How to Prepare Research Proposal' on Wednesday, 24th August 2022 in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College. The workshop was arranged to acquaint the students about preparation of Research proposals in the prescribed format by taking into consideration the scheduled pre-registration presentation (round II) for Ph. D. course in the month of Sept 2022. The workshop was inaugurated at the auspicious hands of Dr. Sushama Bhosale, Principal of the college. Dr. Rohidas Dhakane delivered a speech on the basics of preparation of the research proposal. He stated importance of the aims and objectives, hypothetical statement, review of the literature, scope and limitations while doing research. Dr Sanjay Zagade guided students regarding the technical aspects while preparing research proposal.

Dr. Shahaji Karande (S. M. Joshi College, Hadapsar, Pune) explained importance of the selection of topic while preparing the research proposal. 

Generally, the agreed format of a research proposal is expected to include the following:

- Title of the research study (Choosing a topic)
- Introduction
- Rationale & Significance of the study
- Theoretical Orientation
- A statement of aims and objectives
- The methodology & techniques to be used
- Hypothesis
- The conclusions expected & their possible implications
- The Scope and Limitation of the Study:
 - of the scope of the study
 - of limitations
- A plan to carry out the research
- Bibliography

- A research proposal is a concise and coherent summary of your proposed research. It sets out the central issues or questions that you intend to address. It outlines the general area of study within which your research falls, referring to the current state of knowledge and any recent debates on the topic. It also demonstrates the originality of your proposed research.
- A formal or academic research is an elaborate, disciplined, long-drawn, time-bound effort.
- The *New Standard Encyclopedia* points out that research is 'systematic investigation for the purpose of gaining new knowledge'.
